Train Stations

Cromford Railway Station, Lea Road, Cromford, DE4 5JJ, 2.2 Miles

By car

EV charging - there are charging points in Wirksworth in the Market Place (up to 22kW) and the Co-op and it is possible to use the centre's charging point for a £15 charge (you need to bring your own cable).

The nearest **pub** is the Rising Sun in Middleton.

Centre information:

Fire alarm

Should the fire alarm go off during your stay, it is your personal responsibility to evacuate the building and congregate at the assembly point by the large orange wind sock.

Candles, naked flames, BBQs or fireworks including sparklers are strictly prohibited onsite.

Noise must be kept to a minimum after 11pm.

There is a bar open from 1800 on Friday and 1700 on Saturday. The centre is a licensed premise and you may not bring your own alcohol.

Please avoid wearing muddy footwear in the centre. There are boot scrapers available outside the main entrance. If possible, bring some other shoes or 'hut shoes' to wear inside.

Each bedroom has a controllable radiator. Do not cover these as it is a fire risk.
